What are Grand Gatherings or Buy-ins?

These are events that you purchase during the silent auction that give you and your family access to additional community building activities such as:

### What is group bidding?

Group bidding is when you and your friends all get together ahead of GB to go through all the live auction items and decide as a group what you would like to bid on. Then you will assign one person to do the bidding and as a group decide how much you are willing to spend on that experience. At the end of the night the total selling price will be divided by your group. Great Group Bidding auction items would be:

- 1. Hooky with the principal for 4 children.
- 2. Ticket package Great package to share the tickets between multiple families.
- 3. Orlando or Vegas Great for a family trip, Guys/Gals trip, or even a couples trip.
- 4. First table served
- 5. Beautiful and delicious dessert

### Is there a raffle? What can I win?

There are two opportunities to win via raffle. The first is the cash raffle. That is a pre-event sale item. Students will bring home raffle tickets to sell for \$5/ticket or \$50/10 tickets. You do not have to be present to win the cash raffle. First prize is \$500, Second prize is \$250, and Third prize is \$250.
