Christmas Boutique FAQs

What is Christmas Boutique?

Christmas Boutique is a special event for elementary students to have some autonomy in shopping for, wrapping and giving Christmas gifts.

When is Christmas Boutique?

Monday, Dec. 3 and Tuesday, Dec. 4. Your child's class will be scheduled to shop during a time slot on one of those days.

How does it work?

In November we'll send home a form in Thursday folders and via S'more. Your child will fill in the people/pets he or she will be shopping for (up to 10). Each gift costs \$1. Send a check or cash along with your child's shopping list back to school before the event.

On your child's shopping day, Boutique helpers will assist your child in finding and wrapping gifts for the people/pets on their list. Gifts will be sent home in a bag with their list attached.

Who is invited to shop?

All students enrolled in LADC and K-4th are invited to shop.

Who should my child buy for?

Many children enjoy shopping for parents, grandparents, siblings and extended family. We also have gift options for the family cat & dog! Children are NOT allowed to shop for themselves. 'Tis the season to give!

Where does the event take place?

The Boutique is held during school hours in the Youth Ministry rooms at IHM. Children will walk through a winter wonderland with their teachers, and will arrive at the Boutique

How can I be involved?

Help your child make their list legible!

If you want to volunteer during the event, we're always looking for help setting up, tearing down, and helping the students shop and wrap!

Is this a fundraiser?

No! This is a fun event for the students to help them celebrate Christmas. They spend time thinking of those they love and remember that the best part of Christmas gifts is in the giving!
