

NDA SUMMER CAMP 2019!









Overview

NDA Summer Camp is a full day summer program for current Notre Dame Academy students entering 1st through 8th grade focusing on providing students with a safe and stimulating environment in the summer months. Students will participate in weekly structured activities incorporating art, STEM, reading and language arts, music, theater, and even cooking! Join Mr. Stephens and Ms. Katie Dennehy on this summer adventure!

What days is the camp offered?

• June 10 - August 9, Monday - Friday. (9 weeks) *No CAMP JULY 4 AND 5*

What are the hours of the camp each day?

• Drop-off starting at 7am and pick-up by 6pm, Monday - Friday.

What will my child do each day at camp?

- Students will participate in structured activities related to the weekly theme (see opposite side), enjoy swimming at Shady Oak Beach and take weekly field trips to fun locations around town! Students will also spend time outside and play group games in the NDA gym.
- New this year, students will be able to spend time in the NDA library, visit the NDA technology lab, and also help build and tend an NDA garden!

How much does it cost?

- \$45/family summer camp registration fee (\$25/family if registration is turned in by April 15).
- \$50/day or \$220/week per child.
- There will be an additional fee for field trips of approximately \$20 per trip.
- All billing (registration, field trip and camp fees) will be done through your TADS account.
- Families will be charged for the days/weeks indicated on their registration.
- Refunds will not be allowed, but changing or adding of days will be considered on a case-by-case basis based on staffing and space availability.
- Students must be registered for the 2019-20 school year to attend camp.

What about Shady Oak Beach?

- NDA Summer Camp will visit Shady Oak Beach each Tuesday (all students in attendance must go to the beach). Students are highly encouraged to purchase or renew a 'Shady Oak Beach Pass', which is not included in the program fee; Students are asked to purchase the pass prior to their first beach day.
- The pass is \$13 for Hopkins, Minnetonka and St. Louis Park residents and \$26 for nonresidents if purchased by June 7. Passes can be purchased by calling 952-939-8203. Pass renewal can be done online at eminnetonka.com/register
- Students that do not purchase a Beach Pass will be required to purchase a daily entrance admission.

Field Trips?

- Students will go on field trips each Thursday (all students in attendance must go on the field trip).
- A one-time permission slip for all field trips will be filled out and turned in at the start of the camp.

Does my child need to bring a lunch?

• Children are required to bring a cold lunch and beverage each day. School lunch will not be provided.

Will snack be provided?

• A morning and afternoon snack will be provided daily.
