The money raised helps to fill the gap between the actual cost to educate our students and the cost of tuition. The cost to educate a child at NDA is \$10,781 and our tuition this year is \$5,250. This includes everything from curriculum enhancements to salaries and building upgrades so that we can continue to educate our children at the highest standards as well as give them a faith based education.

#### How much do the tickets cost and what is included in that?

Full ticket prices are \$100. First time attendees and past parents attending GB are offered a reduced ticket costing \$75. NDA has decided to incentivize first time families and encourage old friends to participate! We understand it is a financial commitment and we want to try our best to include everyone. With the full ticket you will receive the opportunity to bid on both live and silent auction items, play heads and tails, enjoy a full sit-down dinner, create memories with friends and support our incredible school. We also have a mini-ticket option. The mini-ticket costs \$40 and allows the purchasers to attend the silent auction from 5:30-7:30pm with appetizers included.

#### What are teacher treats?

# What is group bidding?

Group bidding is when you and your friends all get together ahead of GB to go through all the live auction items and decide as a group what you would like to bid on. Then you will assign one person to do the bidding and as a group decide how much you are willing to spend on that experience. At the end of the night the total selling price will be divided by your group. Great Group Bidding auction items would be:

## Is there a raffle? What can I win?

Yes! We will have a cash raffle. This is a pre-event sale item. Students will bring home raffle tickets to sell for \$5/ticket or \$50/10 tickets. You do not have to be present to win the cash raffle. First prize is \$500, Second prize is \$250, and Third prize is \$250.
