

A message from the Hair & Make-Up Committee:



Dear Parents of 6th, 7th and 8th Graders,

Due to individual skin needs and wishing to avoid potential skin sensitivities to makeup, we are asking you to send in makeup for your child. If your child is an eighth or seventh grader, you may still have some makeup items from last year's play (it is recommended to replace mascara however.) Listed below are the items that each child needs to **bring to school by Monday, February 24th**. If we do not receive supplies for your child we will put together a bag with unused items that have been donated.

Individually label all items, including lipstick, and put in Ziploc bag (or a toiletry bag) with your child's name on it. We want to be sure you get your items back after the play. Items can be dropped in the boxes outside of the music room.

**Please note you will receive a separate list regarding costume needs from the Costume Committee.*

Girls:

- Liquid Foundation - 2 shades darker than skin color
**darker complexions may wear same skin-colored foundation*
- Lipstick- long lasting preferred. Darker pink than normal shade of lip, but no reds.
- Eye Shadow – color that compliments your eye color
- Eyeliner - whatever compliments hair color: blonde/light brown – brown eyeliner, dark brown/black – black eyeliner
- Blush - rosy pink
- Mascara - brown or black (to match hair)
- Sponges to apply foundation
- Brush/Comb
- Hair binders
- Curling Iron (if you do not have one do not purchase one, there will be some on hand)
- Washcloth and hand towel

Boys:

- Liquid Foundation - 2 shades darker than skin color
**darker complexions may wear same skin-colored foundation*
- Lipstick - long lasting preferred. Muted, no "bright" colors please.
- No eye shadow
- Eyeliner- whatever compliments hair color: blonde/light brown - brown eyeliner, dark brown/black – black eyeliner
- Blush – natural or muted blush color, nothing "bright"
- Mascara- brown or black (to match hair)
- Sponges to apply foundation
- Brush/Comb
- Washcloth and hand towel



Additional helpful items:

We will provide cotton balls, hair spray, facial moisturizer, finishing spray, make up removal wipes. Some optional items you may want to consider are lip moisturizer, hand held mirror or mirror stand if you have one, your own make up wipes if you want/need specific brand.

Mrs. Wukmir and the committee will be showing a “how-to” tutorial to the students with some basic instructions on application, contouring, etc.
