- Completed VIRTUS training course – documentation of this course must be on file in the school/church office before the start of the season. VIRTUS classes are online at Virtus.org)
- Signed Code of Conduct

Student-Athlete Commitment

As a member of the Notre Dame Academy community, you are expected to conduct yourself at all times in a manner that reflects the finest qualities of our student/athletes. As a representative of our school, it is expected that you model good citizenship, a commitment to learning and academic achievement, and good sportsmanship. By reading and signing this commitment you agree to:

- Conduct yourself in a manner that reflects the best in an NDA student; whether it be during school, during practice, traveling to/from competition, or at the opponent's school/place of competition, you are expected to model the qualities of a good citizen and member of our Catholic School – Notre Dame Academy.
- Demonstrate good sportsmanship and respect for your teammates, coaches, referees and opponents. You have an obligation to report an act of unsportsmanlike conduct to the team coach or Athletic Director. Unsportsmanlike behavior will result in the loss of play time in competition.
- Consistently be on time for practices and game and be properly dressed for athletic competition. Any player missing over 50% of school during one day cannot participate in competition that day.
- Be present to play in at least 75% of your teams' games to be eligible to participate in the year-end tournament.
- Students must maintain a C grade or better to play or practice for a week.
- Students with missing work may also be kept from participating for the week, and player eligibility will be evaluated each week.

Team Formation/Registration

Notre Dame Academy embraces a philosophy that offers students/athletes the best opportunity for a successful team/athletic experience. This is consistently realized when students play at their own grade level. Student participation drives team formation based on the number of athletes who register to play. As registrations come in for the winter season, the Athletic Director will endeavor to build a team of students in the same grade. There is always the chance that your child may play with another grade level to form a team. In the event this occurs, it is the expectation of the Athletic Director and school administration that you will support whatever decision is made relative to your child's participation/placement on a team.
