## What is NDA Summer Camp?

- NDA Summer Camp is Notre Dame Academy's summer program for students entering grades 1 through 8.
- Students will participate in activities related to the weekly theme incorporating art, STEM, writing and language arts, music, theater, and even cooking!
- We strive to provide a safe, fun, and educational environment for all participants.

## When is camp offered?

- Monday through Friday beginning June 6 and ending August 13
- Open daily from 7am to 6pm
- CLOSED July 1, 2 & 5
- CLOSED July 19-23 for Totus Tuus Vacation Bible Camp at IHM.

## How much does it cost?

- \$45 family Registration Fee (\$25 if registration is submitted by April 30)
- \$50 per student, per day
- Registration and camp fees will be billed to your TADS account in 1 or 2 installments during the summer as indicated on your registration

## What does a typical day at camp look like?

- Mornings and afternoons typically consist of periods of free play, outdoor play, and a structured activity. Students will also visit the school library, play gym games, and enjoy snacks. Students must bring a cold lunch each day.
- All students will follow COVID safety guidelines including wearing masks indoors, undergoing temperature checks and practicing social distancing.
