#### What is NDA Summer Camp?

- NDA Summer Camp is Notre Dame Academy's summer program for students entering grades 1 though 8.
- Students will participate in activities related to each weekly theme incorporating art, STEM, writing & language arts, music, theater, and even cooking!
- We strive to provide a safe, fun, and educational environment for all participants.

#### When is camp offered?

- Monday through Friday beginning
  June 5 and ending August 11
- Open daily from 7am to 5:30pm
- CLOSED June 19-23 for Totus Tuus Vacation Bible Camp at IHM.
- CLOSED July 3 & 4

#### How much does it cost?

- \$45 family Registration Fee
- \$55 per student, per day
- Registration and camp fees will be billed to your TADS account in 1 or 2 installments.
- Additional \$25 Field Trip and \$15 Beach Day Fees for each trip attended. Beach fee waived for each full week registered.

#### What does a typical day at camp look like?

- Mornings and afternoons consist of periods of indoor and outdoor free play and structured activities. Students will also visit the school library and play organized group games.
- On Wednesdays, students will participate in the "activity of the week," like our annual NDA Olympics and NDA Carnival.
- Students must bring a cold lunch each day they attend. A morning and afternoon snack will be provided.
